## Super Singles Playoffs Rules:

- IFP singles points will be used to determine your Singles rank.
- Winner of each event will qualify for Super Singles Playoffs; you can have only 1 spot in Super Singles Playoffs.
- If the same player wins multiple singles events then their playoff spot is determined by the highest event they win and they earn the payout for $2^{\text {nd }}$ place in the lower event(s).
- Handicaps in the Super Singles playoff are determined by the event that a player wins, not by the player's ranking. For example, if an expert player wins Pro Singles, their handicap is 7 (Pro handicap), not 6, because he won the Pro event. Similarly, whoever wins Open Singles has a Pro Master handicap (8).
- Matches are 1 game, first player to their number (\#) wins. See the number you play to in the bracket on the cover page of this flyer.
- If players have the same number (\#) they play to 8
- Player giving point spot will get the first drop. If opponents' number (\#) is the same, then coin flip determines drop.


## Super Doubles Playoffs Rules:

- IFP doubles points will be used to determine your Doubles rank.
- Winner of each event will qualify for Super Doubles Playoffs; you can have only 1 spot in Super Doubles Playoffs.
- If the same team wins multiple doubles events then their playoff spot is determined by the highest event they win and they earn the payout for $2^{\text {nd }}$ place in the lower event(s).
- Handicaps in the Super Doubles playoff are determined by the event that a team wins, not by the team's ranking. For example, if an expert team wins Pro Doubles, their handicap is 7 (Pro handicap), not 6 , because they won the Pro event. Similarly, whoever wins Open Doubles has a Pro Master handicap (8)
- Matches are 1 game, first team to their number (\#) wins. See the number you play to in the bracket on the cover page of this flyer
- If teams have the same number (\#) they play to 8.
- Team giving point spot will get the first drop. If opposing teams' number (\#) is the same, then coin flip determines drop.

Additional Important Information:

- There will be a total of 128 players in this tournament across all 5 Rankings. After 128 players are signed up and entry fees are received, all brackets will be closed.
- Open Doubles, Open Singles, Pro Doubles, Pro Singles, Expert Doubles, and Expert Singles will be seeded; all other events are not.
- You MUST enter as a TEAM and play with the same partner in every bracket in this tournament for all doubles events.
- All Playoffs matches will have a Ref.
- Only package deals are available for this tournament.
- Lower rank players who partner with higher ranked players can only play doubles events for which the higher ranked player is Split ran
- Split ranked players must buy the package for the higher rank, but will be allowed to buy into eligible lower ranked events (\$30 per eligible event).
Playoffs payouts will be made by check. $\$ 10,000$ guaranteed
- Payment has to be received 2 weeks after reserving your spot; otherwise you will automatically go on the waiting list. Contact me to send your payment.
- Once I receive your payment I will lock you in all brackets where you qualify. No Money Back.
- Registration will close 1 week prior to the tournament so we can create all brackets ahead of time and post them online.
- If you are flying in I will arrange a pickup for you, so let me know your flight information.
